CUP FEEDING

With the cup leaning on the

baby's lower lip and the milk

barely touching the lips.

Holding baby in semi-sitting position.Press tip of teat to

lower lip.

BOTTLE FEEDING

RISEINFAMILY

Babies can be breastfed as soon as they are strong enough.



When babies are not strong enough, the mother can express her milk and feed it to her baby in different ways.



SYRINGE FEEDING

Placing the syringe in the corner of the mouth (not inside) without injecting the milk.



During **kangaroo care**, bring your baby closer to the breast **when you notice he's alert.**





You can advance on oral feeding with sensitivity and motor stimulation.



TUBE FEEDING
Using a tiny tube that goes through nose or mouth into the baby's stomach.



FINGER-SYRINGE FEEDING

Introducing the tip of a clean finger that stimulates the baby to suck.





Sucking from breast and from a little container of milk at the same time may help with breastfeeding production for weak preterm. nlalanda
